MUSEUM PARTNERS WITH THE ALVISO ADOBE COMMUNITY PARK  
FOR THIS YEAR'S CELEBRATE COMMUNITY FAMILY DAY

*September 9, 2021- Pleasanton, CA* – Join the Museum on Main on Saturday, September 18<sup>th</sup> from 10am-2pm on the museum's front lawn for our Celebrate Community Family Day. This year the museum's Celebrate Community Partner is the Alviso Adobe Community Park. "We feel very fortunate to be a part of a community with so many amazing organizations working to enrich the lives of Pleasanton and Tri-Valley residents. It is an honor to be able to partner with and help spotlight one of these great organizations each year through our Celebrate Community Family Day," notes Sarah Schaefer, the Museum on Main's Director of Education. "We are thrilled to be working with the Alviso Adobe Community Park this September."

The Alviso Adobe's fully restored interpretative park reveals the history of the Amador Valley. It offers a rare glimpse of times past - from its Native American beginnings to the days of Spanish Ranchos, through a period in the early to mid-20th century when it was a popular dairy and finally to its present use as a community park. "The Alviso Adobe is such an amazing community resource, and we are eager to bring just a fraction of what they have to offer to Downtown Pleasanton for our September family day" adds Schaefer.

The museum's front lawn will be packed with a variety of activities highlighting both the historic and natural assets that make the Alviso Adobe Community Park so unique. These will include: a hands-on archaeological activity, Ohlone game of staves, making diseños with oak gall ink, leaf rubbing, a live animal exhibit, and much more!

This event is part of the Museum on Main's 2021 Family Days, which are free weekend events on select Saturdays from June to September. Family Days are open to the public and are an

avenue for children, parents, and grandparents to enjoy hands-on learning opportunities. Activities at Family Days are free of charge and no reservations are required. You won't want to miss this unique opportunity, in the heart of downtown Pleasanton, to learn about the many inhabitants with which we share our environment and history.

The Museum on Main is located at 603 Main Street in historic downtown Pleasanton.
